Trash Pickup Services/HOA Rules on Trash

Trash Pickup Days—Every Tuesday and Friday

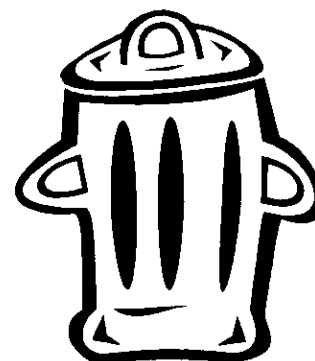
Yard Debris Pickup—(grass, branches, leaves) Every Wednesday

Recycling Pickup—Every Friday

Please Note: AAA will not pickup leaves, branches, sticks or other yard debris unless it is properly bundled or bagged. If you put branches, bushes or leaves out to the curb and they are not packaged properly, AAA will NOT pick them up. To ensure pickup, cut the branches into pieces that fit into a trash bag. If you have questions regarding these issues or need a new trash can or recycling bin, AAA can be reached at 703-818-8222. AAA has office hours from 8:00a.m to 5:00pm, Monday through Friday, and 8:00am to 12 Noon on Saturdays.

HOA guidelines in Franklin Oaks prohibit Franklin Oaks residents from putting trash or yard debris out early. Curbside is not the place to store trash or debris. During the Summer when this is done, the grass clippings are a problem in that they smell badly very quickly. Leaves and branches can create a mess on windy, autumn days. Please refrain from putting these items out early. The night before or the day of pickup is proper. Any earlier is not considered appropriate.
